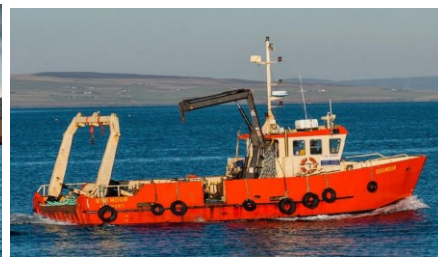

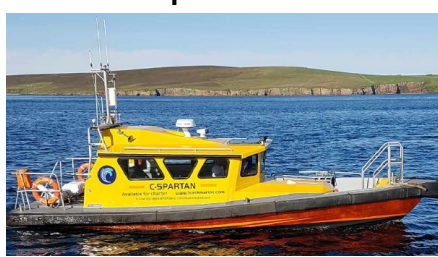

Vessels are requested to maintain a safe distance of 250 meters from the above coordinates.

## Details of lights, buoys and other navigational aids

Special mark buoy:

Buoy diameter approximately 1.5m around the waterline with a yellow "X" top mark 2m above that level.

Mooring Buoys are marked with Colour yellow - flash yellow light – 1 FY5s – Light range 1nm

Flash Pattern



During peak times of tide, buoys may be submerged up to 5m.

## Proposed routes of vessels involved in installation (from port to site)

Main Vessels Route: EMEC Tidal Test Site to Kirkwall

Orkney VTS will be notified of all operations and movements

## Details of any areas to be avoided

Vessels are requested to maintain a minimum distance of 250 meters from the stated Co-ordinates submitted.

## INSTRUCTIONS TO VESSELS

Vessels involved will be keeping continuous listening watch on Channel 16 and 6 and will display appropriate lights and marks as required by the International Rules for Preventing Collisions at Sea. Mariners are requested to give the works a wide berth.
