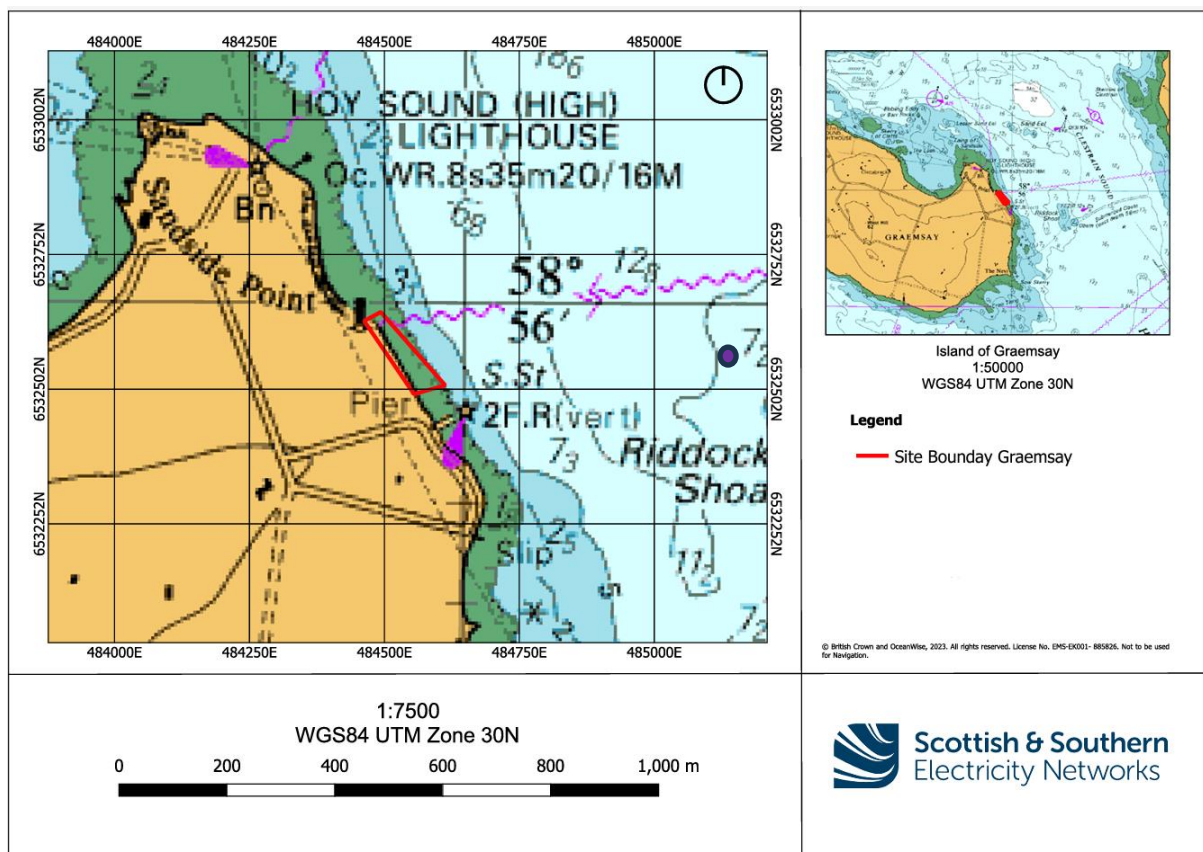
Vessels and General Safety Advice

Scottish Hydro Electric Power Distribution (SHEPD)
Orkney Remedial Works

Date of Issue: 11th April 2024

Please be advised that Briggs Marine Contractors (on behalf of SHEPD) will be removing an Out of Service (OOS) subsea electricity cable. The removal works will be carried out between low and high water on the shore on Graemsay.

Please refer to Figure 1, that shows the location of the planned works, please also refer to Table 1 overleaf that lists the coordinates for the area.



Works at Graemsay landfall will commence 2nd May and are expected to take 1 day to complete.

Site personnel will be removing an OOS subsea cable between low and high water at the Graemsay landfall. A pioneer support boat will be utilised to offer support to personnel.
