### Details of the works programme

**Title:** Scapa Flow Temporary Duct Storage

**Dates:** 16-01-2025 to 16-04-2025

**Vessel Operation on-site:** C-Spartan

C- Odyssey



**Location:** Scapa Flow: Bay of Deepdale

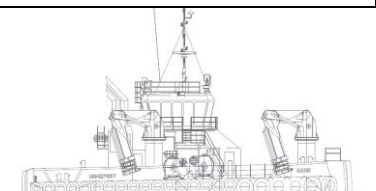
**Operation Summary:** Temporary storage of 1 duct will be inspected weekly.

**Proposed Vessel movements** Orkney Harbours will be notified of all operations and movements.

**Details of any areas to be avoided:** Vessels are requested to maintain a minimum distance of 500m from the box created from the coordinates stated.

**Details of lights, buoys, and other navigational aids**  
 Marker buoys are marked with the Colour yellow - flash yellow light – 1 FY5s – Light range 1nm.  
 Mooring buoys will have one marker light attached 2 lights in total.  
 A4 buoys with reflective SOLAS tape will be installed every 140m along the length of the duct a total of six.

**Instructions to vessels:** Vessels involved will be keeping continuous listening watch on Channel 16 and 6 and will display appropriate lights and marks as required by the International Rules for Preventing Collisions at Sea.  
 Mariners are requested to give the area a wide berth.

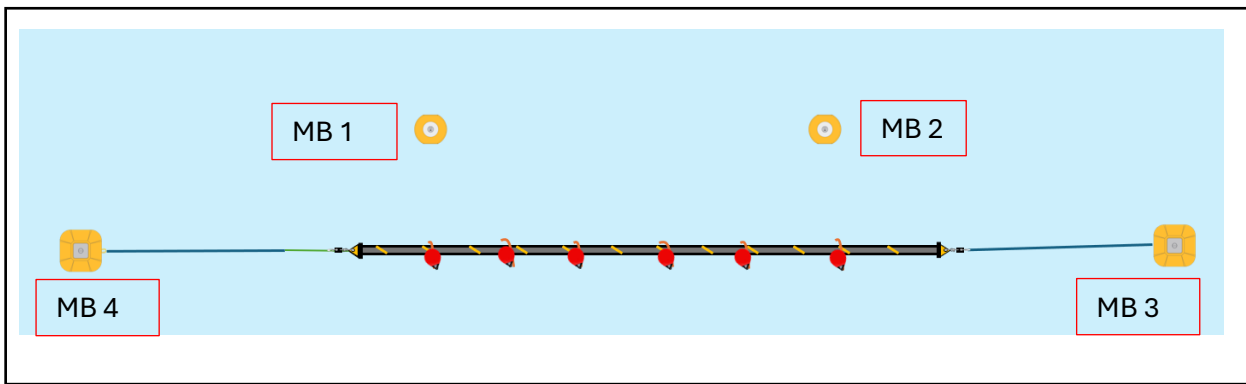

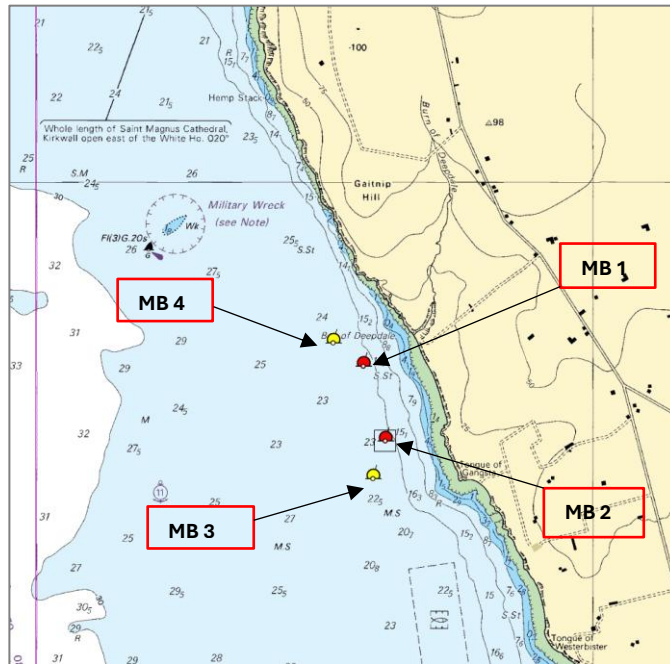
