NOTES

1.1 Details of works programme including period & purpose

Acoustic survey of the EMEC tidal test site area at Fall of Warness, off Eday, two days between 11/8/25 to 13/8/25 (Fall of Warness) weather dependant,.

The work will involve the release of up to two buoyed drifting drogues within the area of the EMEC tidal test site and allow them to drift with the tide over the site. The buoys will be deployed, retrieved and accompanied by the vessel "**EFJA**" operated by Orbital Amrine Power (Fall of Wanress). Anticipated duration of the work in the area is six hours per day.

Vessels in the area are requested to keep a look out for and avoid the drifting equipment. On the surface they are composed of an orange pot buoy (50 cm diameter), floating grey case, red flag and flashing navigational light. Each unit will be independently free floating with the tide (as shown in the below figure).




Figure 1. Buoyed drifting acoustic drogue
